Reliability of Host Lists - History

There was growing unreliability of Host Lists in certain countries.

To correct this, the GA asked EXCO to set up a testing system.

This system would be operated by telephone by the « Host List Coordinator » or a person working with him from outside EXCO. It would consist of confirming the validity of the « status data » of a random sample of the Hosts of each country.

The Host list of each country could thus be checked at least once every two years

The results of this testing would be communicated to all national groups. It would be up to the « unreliable » countries to correct their Host List as soon as they are informed of its unreliability.

Next Steps

Whether your country has a reliable list or not, it is important to have the new 2011 host list available as soon as possible.

The team will be working in 2011 giving support to member groups that do not have updated or reliable host lists. We will also support national groups that are not yet members groups, in cooperation to the Development Committee, in order to bring those countries closer to be proposed for membership status in 2012.
